Grace to you and peace in Christ.

On behalf of the session and members of First Presbyterian Church, Harrison, Arkansas, welcome to the Ozark Mountains, where this part of Christ's Body gathers. We hope that you are enjoying the colors of fall that are so splendid this time of year and that your drive was full of the beauty of the earth. We are honored to be able to host the Presbytery of Arkansas and want to make your time here the best it can be. So please let any of us know if you need something or if there is anything we can do to make your stay more enjoyable.

For over a century Presbyterians have gathered on Spring Street in Harrison. It was Easter 2007 that we made the historic move to this new land God has given us on Arbor Drive. We celebrated our last services in the old building on Maundy Thursday and Good Friday. As we normally do every year during these holy days we stripped the church, and stood in the shadow of the cross. Our last evening at the old building took on a powerful depth of meaning as we remembered Christ's death, and the death of an old way of life for this community. The next day we gathered everything we could: Bibles, hymnals, candlesticks, offering plates, and the processional cross crafted from the cross that hung in our sanctuary which was fixed to a staff of black walnut by two of our members Ralph Parkinson and Underwood Mitchell. With all these things in hand and with all the emotions you can imagine, we walked the 2.2 mile pilgrimage to this new land. Our first service in this facility was held the next day, Easter Sunday. We welcomed 16 new members, baptized children and adults and celebrated Christ's resurrection and our new life in a new place. And like the women in Mark's Gospel we were scared and filled with awe and joy.

And today we are so grateful that you have gathered with us to worship, study and do the business of the Presbytery of Arkansas. Our ingathering is for Ozark Share and Care, a local non-profit shelter and store where those who are hungry find food, the naked are clothed and the stranger is welcomed as Christ. The workshops for this presbytery meeting cover a wide range of subjects for the church and we hope that you will find one that will help equip you for ministry. These workshops begin at 3p.m. Thursday and there are signs and people to help direct you to the one you are attending. The gavel will sound at 6:30 p.m. Thursday evening. There is a reception following the evening worship in the gathering space of our church. This is the space where we gather for our first worship service each Lord's Day. Friday's lunch will be prepared by Homey Hearth, a bakery run by our Mennonite sisters and brothers. Lunch tickets are available.

We are so glad you are here and praise God that we can gather together as sisters and brothers of this part of Christ's Body known as the Presbytery of Arkansas. As we accentuate our unity in Christ at this gathering we will remember that the church is born of water and the Spirit. The images of the fonts from all the churches of this presbytery that will appear on the screens will hopefully explode with meaning. While they are very different and we are very different, there is one church and one baptism. And without these differences as well as our common grounding in Christ, we could not be the church we are called to be. It is this mystery we will lift up during our gathering here in the mountains. Thanks be to God!

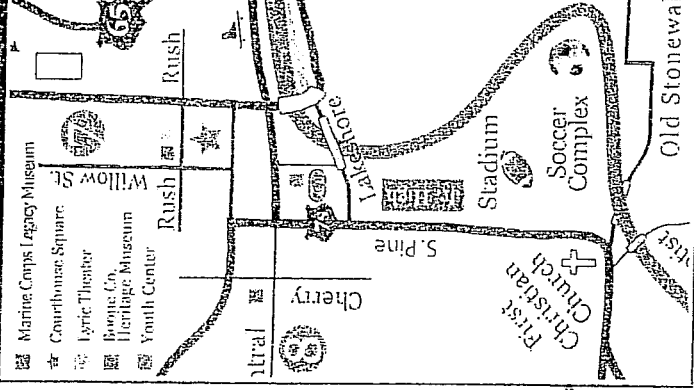

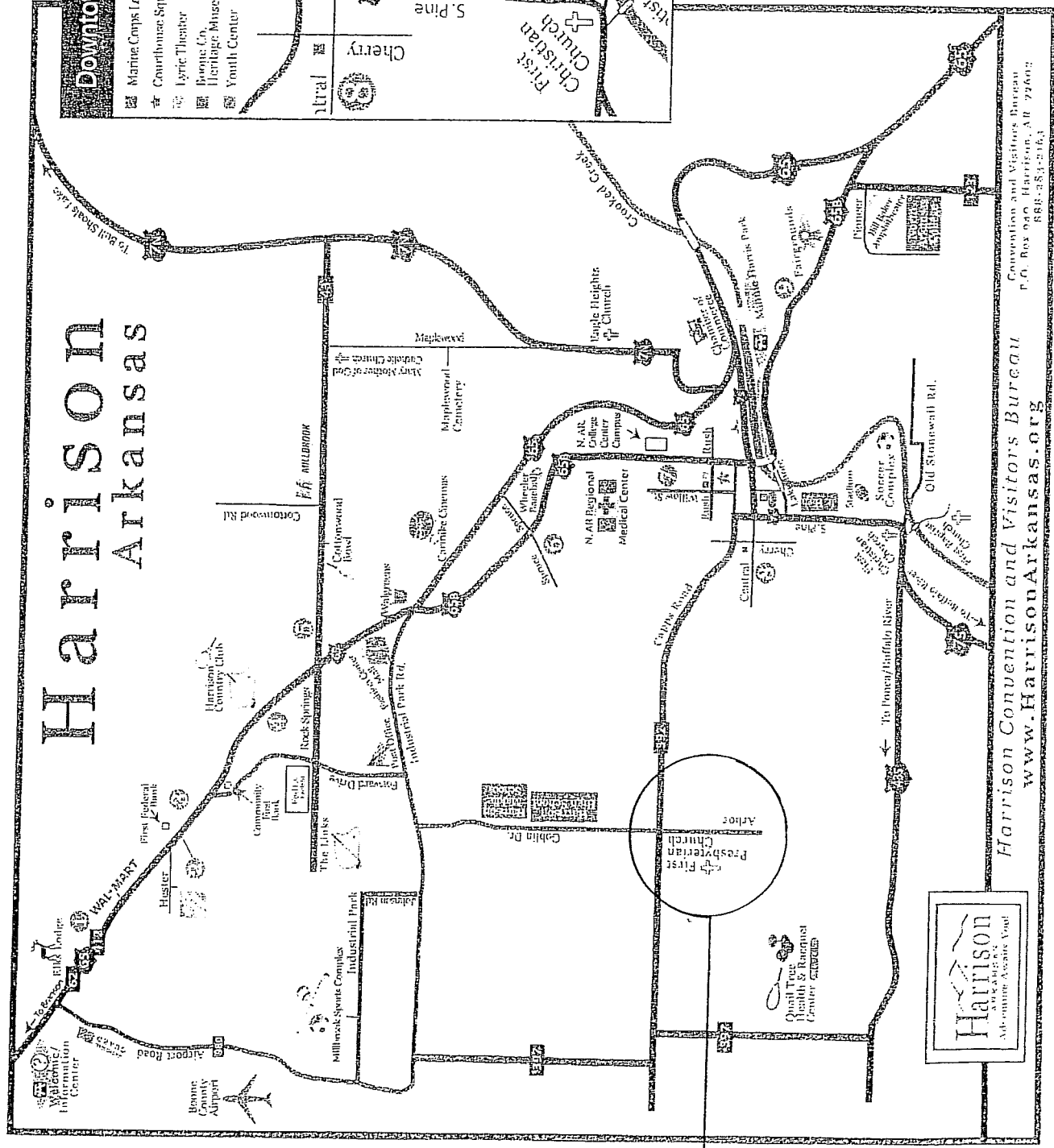

Directions to First Presbyterian Church, Harrison:

From the **South** and **East**: From northbound H65, turn left on Bus H65 and follow to the town square. Turn left on Stephenson and go seven blocks to the five way stop sign. Go straight on Capps Rd. (H392) for about a mile to the signal light (Arbor and Goblin Dr.). The church is that big pretty white edifice on the hill to your left center.

From the **West**: From H412, turn right onto H392 (about 3 mi. east of Alpena). Follow it for about 7 mi. until you reach signal light at Arbor. Church is on the right.
