Christmas:

Veggie Tales: “Holiday Double Feature: The Star of Christmas and The Toy That Saved Christmas” (Acc. #8695) In “The Star”, an action-packed adventure teaches that it’s the true story of God’s love that shows us how to love another—at Christmas and throughout the year! In “The Toy” children of all ages are reminded that “Christmas isn’t about getting; it’s about giving.”

“Nativity: The Art and Spirit of the Creche” (Acc. #8696) examines the history, art and spirituality of the second most recognized Christian symbol (after the cross) and embraced by cultures around the world. Theologians and collectors present an astonishing and beautiful array of nativity scenes from across the globe. 30 minutes.

“Prince of Peace, The: The Christmas Story” (Acc. #8698) relives the Christmas story in 3D animation, for children ages 3 to 10. 29 minutes.

“Red Boots for Christmas” (Acc. #8697) may be viewed in English or Spanish and includes an activity booklet in pdf format. Hans the shoemaker learns the joys of sharing and fellowship and embraces the spirit of Christmas. 28 minutes.

Miscellaneous Children’s DVDs:

Veggie Tales: “Duke and the Great Pie War” (Acc. #8702) is a re-telling of the story of Ruth and Naomi, plus Miriam and Moses. 45 minutes.

Veggie Tales: “Super Silly Fun” (Acc. #8700) is a CD-Rom of four songs, videos and activities (coloring sheets, word search and crossword puzzle and wallpapers) used on your CD player and your computer.

Veggie Tales: “Lord of the Beans” (Acc. #8701) is a “Lesson in Using Your Gifts.” Toto inherits a powerful bean and with his mentor and friends wonders how he should use his gift. 52 minutes.

“How Can I Celebrate Passover? A Young Christian’s Introduction to the Seder” (Acc. #8789) is a puppet show and still-frame animation program about Christian children learning the significance of the ancient feast of Passover. 25 minutes.

YOUTH DVDs

“Exploring God’s Purpose for Your Life” (Acc. #8573) explores the path to finding God’s will, helping young people to hear God’s purpose for their lives. Six segments: God has a purpose, Seeking God, Obstacles to hearing, Trusting God, Making decisions, Steps of faith. Includes a resource book, 40 minutes.

“Jacob’s Ladder: Episode 1 and 2” (Acc. #8790) are live-action dramas geared to youth ages 10-15, for the family or for classroom. Episode 1: Gideon, Reluctant Hero will challenge viewers to lay aside idols and worship the one True God. Episode 2: Gideon, Warrior by Faith teaches dependence on God to do the impossible. Pdf study materials are included. Total 60 minutes.

“Jacob’s Ladder: Episode 3 and 4” (Acc. #8791). Episode 3: Naomi and Ruth teach about facing trials through faith and building healthy communities that reach out to outsiders when cultures clash. Episode 4: Ruth and Boaz center on hard work, the law of the Lord, and a steadfast faith that play a part in success. Total 60 minutes.

“Lord’s Prayer, The: Entering into God’s Country with Walter Wangerin, Jr.” (Acc. #8577) explores the petitions and the structure of the Lord’s Prayer, shedding light on what the prayer reveals about God’s nature and our own. Video is divided into eight segments and includes a study guide. Total 90 minutes.

“Love Is Patient: Saving Sex for Marriage” (Acc. #8756) includes study guide. Also in VHS format. Young people are exposed to the many benefits of saving sex for marriage, a teaching based on I Corinthians 13:4-8a, and with counselors share this message from personal testimonies. Includes a resource/discussion guide. 30 minutes.

“Revolution: A Bible Study for Teenagers” is a five-DVD set of 20-minute video segments accompanied by an 88-page leader’s guide. Sessions include these titles: **“Guilt” (Acc. #8728), “Worry” (Acc. #8729), “Anger” (Acc. #8730), “Doubt” (Acc. #8731) and “Impact” (Acc. #8732).**

“Six Girls Tell the Truth” (Acc. #8336) features high school/college girls who each speak candidly about self-image, media messages, girl pressure and partying. Accompanied by books “Secret Power for Girls” and “Mirror, Mirror.”

“Velocity, A Bible Study for Teenagers: The Mask” (Acc. #8331) with musical artists Switchfoot and David Carr. 20-minute DVD, part 1 of series. Teens will discover that living behind the mask that covers real feelings and actions is dangerous and can obscure their life. They will be encouraged to stop wearing masks and start living authentically with God and with others. Includes reproducible guide.

“Velocity, A Bible Study for Teenagers: The Mourning After” (Acc. #8332). 20-minute DVD, part 2 of series. Teens will learn about God’s purpose for sexuality, why there is still forgiveness for those who have gone too far sexually and ways to avoid the pitfalls. Includes reproducible guide.

“Velocity, A Bible Study for Teenagers: Come What May” (Acc. #8333) with missionary Gracia Burnham. 20-minute DVD, part 3 of series. Teens will discover that God is strong enough to carry them through any hardship and how those hardships can help them grow in their relationships with God. Includes reproducible guide.

“Velocity, A Bible Study for Teenagers: Parental Advisory” (Acc. #8334). 20-minute DVD, part 4 of series. Teens will examine the delicate relationships they balance with their parents, be encouraged to honor parents in a biblical manner and forgive them for their imperfections as God has forgiven us. Includes reproducible guide.

“Velocity, A Bible Study for Teenagers: More To Life” (Acc. #8335). 20-minute DVD, part 5 of series. Teens are challenged to live the life they were born to live, a life of meaning and significance. Includes reproducible guide.

ADULT CLASS BIBLE DVDs

“Gospel of John, The” (Acc. #8574) is the live action 2003 production of the fourth gospel, adapted for the screen, word for word, from the Good News Bible. The feature film is divided between two discs and special features (historical background, academic advisory committee, interactive map, glossary, bibliography) are on the third disc. Total 280 minutes.

“History of the Bible in English” (Acc. #8583) by Kerygma traces the history of today’s Bible from ancient manuscripts to the many modern translations available today, divided among nine chapters. Includes a 22-question overview.

“Parables of Jesus” (Acc. #8792) contains seven short dramas portraying the parables through the lens of Bible times: Good Samaritan, Unmerciful Servant, Treasure and the Pearl, Lost Son, Midnight Visitor, Dinner, Manager. A resource for Bible study, small groups and Sunday School, 58 minutes.

ADULT CLASS GENERAL DVDs

“Christianity and Islam” (Acc. #8575) contains four segments of 25 minutes each on the tenets of Islam, the Trinity, the Bible and the incarnation, and the cross and salvation. Includes 32-page study guide.

“Luther” (Acc. #8576) is the 2003 MGM production with English and Spanish language subtitles. Includes print study guide of “Luther: Biography of a Reformer,” 124 minutes.

“Parenting 101: The Basics of Becoming a Proactive Parent” (Acc. #8582) contains four weekly sessions on navigating through life, developing

a plan, managing the ‘balancing act,’ and keeping strong. Includes print student workbook, total 60 minutes.

“Next Door Savior: Near Enough to Touch, Strong Enough to Trust” (Acc. #8624) by Max Lucado is a boxed evangelism curriculum containing the hardback book, leader’s guide, participant’s guide, pamphlet, hymn music CD, two videos, and DVD for group study for 8 sessions.

“The Four Chaplains” (Acc. #8625) is the classic documentary of four military chaplains (Roman Catholic, Jewish, and two Protestants) who gave their lives in 1943 so others could survive. Useful particularly for patriotic or war-time studies, 54 minutes.

“God’s Mission of Gathering” (Acc. #8626) from PC(USA) is divided among the four challenges for international mission: witnessing worldwide, equipping the church, ministries of reconciliation, and living the good news with the poor. 12 minutes.

“Making Marriage Work: A Biblical Look at Marriage” is a four-DVD set accompanied by a 63-page leader’s guide and 10 workbooks. Sessions include: **“Making Marriage Work: Myths” (Acc. #8733)**; **“Making Marriage Work: Pressure” (Acc. #8734)**; **“Making Marriage Work: Conflict” (Acc. #8735)**; and **“Making Marriage Work: Faith” (Acc. #8736)**. 24 minutes each.
